BOND MARKET

The 10-year benchmark (6.33% GS 2035) recorded a close of 6.5997%, ending 0.30 bps higher than the close of the previous day's trading session.

DOMESTIC BROADCAST

Indian bond yields have surged on weak demand, with the 10-year jumping 24 bps in August to 6.62% amid fiscal worries after GST tax cut plans, a "buyers' strike" by insurers, pension funds, and banks, and rising government supply. The spike has derailed monetary transmission, forcing firms like HUDCO and Bajaj Finance to shelve fundraising. Traders urge RBI intervention through open market operations or bond swaps to stabilize yields, warning that higher borrowing costs could blunt the impact of rate cuts and liquidity support.

On AUGUST 25, 2025, the overnight money market volume was ₹670429.03 crore at a 5.39% average rate. Net liquidity absorption was ₹179528.33 crore.

GLOBAL BROADCAST

Wall Street was flat on Tuesday as rising Treasury yields and Trump's unprecedented removal of Fed Governor Lisa Cook raised concerns over Fed independence ahead of its policy meeting. Investors awaited Nvidia's earnings and key inflation data, critical for Al-driven momentum and rate-cut bets. At 9:49 a.m. ET, the Dow slipped 26 points, the \$&P 500 fell 8 points, and the Nasdaq dropped 54 points, with communication services leading losses. Nvidia edged lower, while AMD rose 1.6% on an upgrade, Eli Lilly jumped 4.2% on positive trial data, and EchoStar surged 76% after a \$23B AT&T spectrum deal. Treasury yields climbed, the dollar weakened, and capital goods orders beat expectations.

French markets tumbled Tuesday as fears grew that Prime Minister François Bayrou's minority government could collapse after opposition parties refused to back his September 8 confidence vote on budget cuts. The CAC 40 slid over 2% to a three-week low, with BNP Paribas and SocGen plunging 6%+, while midcaps fell nearly 3%. French 10-year yields spiked to 3.53%, widening the France-Germany spread to 79 bps, the highest since April.

SPREAD ANALYSIS

The India 10 Years vs the United States 10 Years Government Bond spread value is 229.77 bps, 1.2 bps lower than the closing of the previous day.

- 2 Years vs 1 Years bond spread is 27.22 bp.

MARKET OUTLOOK

Today, the 10-year benchmark yields ended slightly compared to the previous day, the market experienced good liquidity and yield movement. The yield is projected to fluctuate between 6.55% and 6.60%.
